





Information for our disabled passengers

From guide dogs to wheelchairs

Everything which is necessary for disabled people, we transport free of charge. These include for example, orthopaedic aids, hospital wheelchairs and also guide dogs.

Piers and boarding the boats

The two large and modern passenger boats MS TEGERNSEE and MS ROTTACH-EGERN are equipped for disabled people and are used on the Grand tour. Boarding for the Grand tour is in Tegernsee Rathaus (Town Hall, pier 1), Rottach-Egern Strandbad (Lido), Bad Wiessee Ortsmitte (Town Centre), Kaltenbrunn and Gmund Seeglas.

Access to the two large passenger boats takes place depending on the water level or slightly sloped via a wheelchair-friendly transition bridge. On the transition bridges, a small threshold of about 5 cm (tripping hazard!) needs to be overcome. Our team will be happy to help you.

The **piers** in Tegernsee Rathaus (Town Hall, pier 1), Bräustüberl and Seesauna, in Rottach-Egern Überfahrt and Strandbad, in Abwinkl, Bad Wiessee Ortsmitte (Town Centre), Gmund Seeglas and Kaltenbrunn are reachable **without steps**.

The piers Tegernsee Rathaus (Town Hall, pier 2), Rottach-Egern Bachmair are reachable with 1 to 4 steps. These piers are operated with the smaller boats within the framework of the southern round trips and one-way trips.

Boarding the small boats takes place without a transition bridge. Here, there is a small gap between the pier and the boat. The boarding height varies depending on the water level.

In case of a stronger waves (e.g. when windy), it is likely that the boats may move up and down during the boarding process, especially the smaller boats.

Onboard

MS TEGERNSEE and MS ROTTACH-EGERN

- The two identical sister boats each have a disabled toilet.
- Main deck and sun deck: the large salon on the upper deck and the open areas in the forecastle area are reachable without steps. The sun deck in the rear area can be reached by an external staircase with 5 steps and the upper deck with a further 7 steps.

- For wheelchair users, there is enough wide entry and easily accessible main deck salon.
- Gastronomy on board.

Tip: We recommend people with disabilities sail on the MS TEGERNSEE or MS ROTTACH-EGERN. The boats depart daily on the Grand tour (Lines A and B). Use the piers in Tegernsee Rathaus (Town Hall, pier 1), Rottach-Egern Strandbad (Lido) and Bad Wiessee Ortsmitte (Town Centre).

MS GMUND, MS KREUTH and MS WALLBERG

- These smaller passenger boats do not have toilet facilities.
- The salons and decks can only be reached via steps from the midships area.
- These smaller passenger boats (Linie C und D) sind nicht rollstuhlgerecht.

Disabled Parking

Available near the piers Tegernsee Rathaus (Town Hall), Rottach-Egern Strandbad (Lido), Bad Wiessee Ortsmitte (Town Centre) and Gmund Seeglas.

Public toilets for disabled people

Located near the piers Tegernsee Town Hall, Tegernsee Seesauna, Rottach-Egern Lido, Bad Wiessee Town Centre and Gmund Seeglas.

Recommendation and Contact

Please ask for information one day before your desired sailing directly at the administration of Tegernsee Shipping, regarding the operating times of the disabled-friendly boats. Boat charters often require a flexible allocation of boats. However, Tegernsee Shipping always strives to operate at least the Line A with a disabled-friendly passenger boat. You can reach us.
